



ST Elevation Myocardial Infarction (MI) with onset of symptoms less than 12 hours

- 1. Activate Referral PCI Hospital & EMS Transport
- 2. Monitor, Oxygen, IV with saline
- 3. Aspirin 325 mg PO or PR
- 4. Clopidogrel (Plavix) 600 mg P0 (Class I indication) (If patient takes Plavix, lower to 300 mg P0.)

OR Prasugrel (Effient) 60 mg PO (Class I indication) (Do not use if age > 75, weight < 60 kg or history of prior TIA or CVA.)

Some PCI centers may prefer to use Integrilin 180 mcg/kg bolus (ClassIIb indication) in lieu of Plavix or Effient.

- 5. Nitroglycerin 0.4 mg SL (repeat as needed or IV)
- 6. Heparin: loading dose of 60 units/kg IV (4,000 units max)
 OR
 Lovenox 30 mg IV
- 7. Morphine Sulfate as needed for pain
- 8. Second IV saline locked
- 9. Attach hands-free defibrillator pads
- **10.** In-the-door to out-the-door goal is less than 30 minutes
